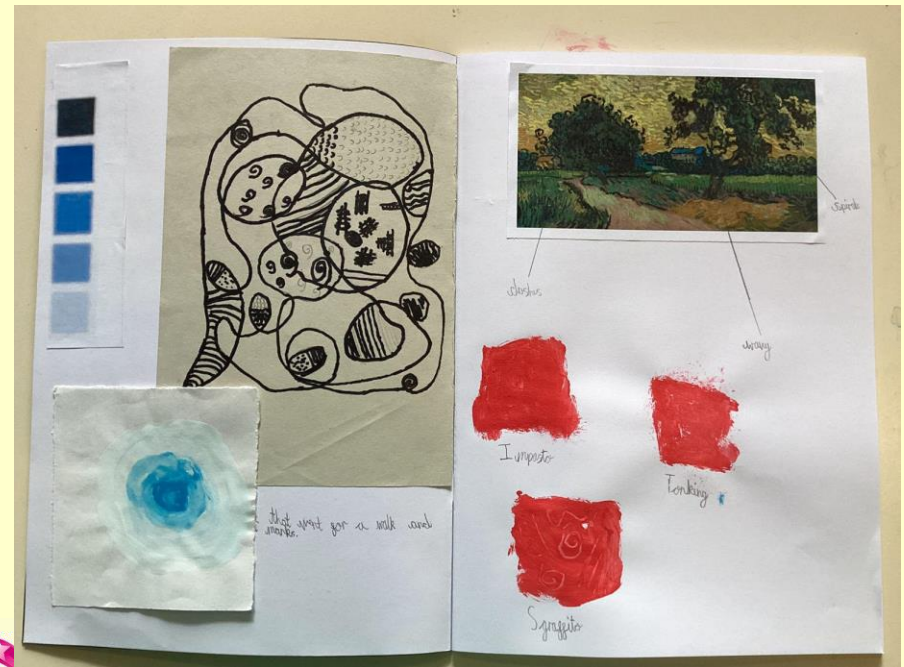


Year 3 are celebrating...
