Can you draw a map of your journey, take some photos or draw what you see.</p>	<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>Choose one of the religions we have studied so far this year and create a fact file with all the information you can remember.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Christianity</li> <li>- Hinduism</li> <li>- Islam</li> </ul>	<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>Research Queen Boudicca. How many amazing facts can you find about her? Create a poster on Word sharing your learning.</p>
