Year 6 are celebrating...

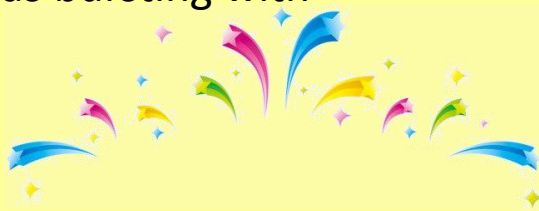
6P - Dalia for her outstanding comic strip depicting the key moments in the Battle of Hastings.
