4H - Cody for working hard and always trying his best. A great start to the year Cody!

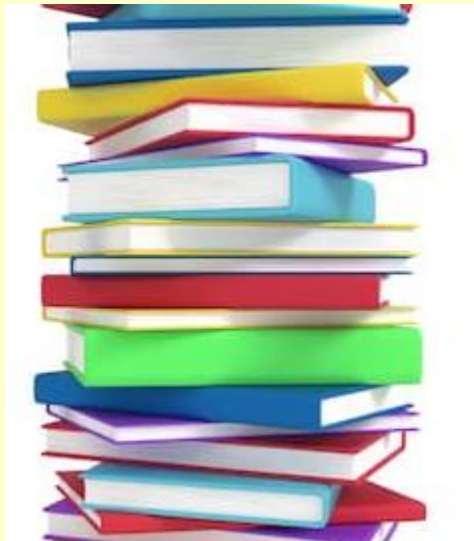
4L- Jasper, Calli and Amelia for a fabulous start to the school year.
