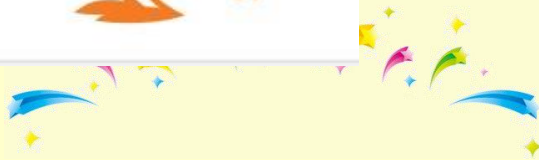


PSHE!
