All of the ambassadors helped to promote the day by creating posters to put around the school and also by sharing a virtual assembly. On the day, we were overwhelmed by how many shoes you all brought in! All the ambassadors (and extra reinforcements) helped to pack the shoes, put them in elastic bands and put them in bin bags.

We are not sure how many shoes we collected in total but Mrs Cook ordered 450 elastic bands and we needed even more! We hope to have raised an enormous amount of money for UNICEF so children all around the world have access to education (Article 28).

We had 42 full bin bags packed with elastic-banded shoes. THAT IS A LOT! We are grateful for all the people that brought shoes and all the ambassadors for their help. Some people brought many pairs of shoes—thank you!

After collecting over 40 bags of shoes, the teachers transported them to Clarks in Ipswich. 3 ambassadors went with Mrs Cook and delivered the final bag of shoes. We all took a photo in and out of Clarks together to show what we have achieved.



With the shoes we all brought in, they will be donated to people in need (Article 26 & 27). Clarks are going to make a donation to UNICEF to provide equipment to allow children access their right to education (Article 28).
